For example, you might note the absence of convenient storage for maintenance, but don't propose expanding the closet by the side door.

1. Prioritized In order of significance and urgency, list the top three problems or issues your ministry or group sees in the church entry, nursery, former bookstore and front hall/coats areas of the church.
